Recipe of The Season "Oatmeal Applesauce Cookies" (Makes 3 dozen) A member favorite by request!

Ingredients:

- 2/3 C Brown Sugar
- 1/4 C Vegetable oil
- 1 tsp Vanilla
- 1/4 tsp Salt
- 1 1/4 C Applesauce
- 4 C Quick Oats
- 1/2 C Dates, Chopped

Directions:

Preheat oven to 375 degrees and spray cookie sheets with cooking spray. Using a large bowl, thoroughly mix the brown sugar, oil, vanilla and salt. Stir in the applesauce and dates. Drop rounded teaspoons of the dough on the cookie sheets, about 1-inch apart. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes, until the cookies are lightly browned.
